* Due to the limited space of the pool, it is advisable that campers should only come during break times and be sensitive to others who are not part of the family camp. Please be aware that there is a limit that the pool can accommodate and hotel staff may decline people from entering the pool area if it's already crowded.

Things to bring: Guests using the pool will be required to wear swimming appropriate swimming apparels (swimming caps). All children must be minded by an adult at all times. Swimming trunks and suits must be worn (no colored tops).

Johnstown House Main Ballroom (O'Rorke Ballroom):

This is going to be WIN-IRL venue* for all Plenary Sessions, Praise and Worship, Couple's Workshops and Sunday Worship Services. Mobile phones must be kept silent or closed at all times during sessions.

* Except Saturday afternoon up to evening no halls or breakout rooms may be used due to a wedding.

Things to bring: Bible, Pens and Notepads. Guests will be provided conference envelopes for storing programs, notes, hand outs and teaching materials. Please wear ID stickers at all times during sessions.

Hotel Gym:

This is in the Hotel on the right where all exercise equipment and free weights are located. This is free of charge to be used <u>ONLY</u> by registered occupants. Only persons from 18 years old and above are allowed to use Gym facilities.

Things to bring: Own towels. Exercise clothes, energy drinks, and drinking water.

Indoor Swimming Pool/ Jacuzzi:

4 feet deep (deck level) heated pool. This is free to use by registered occupants*. Lockers are supplied. Open from 7am to 7pm for Children and open up to 10pm for Adults.

6. Living Room:

There is complete sofa set which is also convertible to sofa bed. There is a local channel TV / remote. It can connect portable DVD, PS3 and other electronics. There is free internet wire cable connection.

7. Outdoor Play Area:

The grass lawn in front of the apartments can be play areas for children. Parents should mind their children at all times. Children are prohibited from entering the football pitch area. Children can play badminton or other racket sports, football in the green lawns in front of the apartments. No one will be allowed to roam the play areas after lights out.

Things to bring: Families may bring their own badminton, soccer balls and other sports equipments but need to mind them from being loss/stolen.

8. Check Out Time:

House Leaders sure all is in order (house is neat and tidy) before house is vacated. Damage assessment may be conducted. Check out time is on or before 1:00 pm on 16 July. House key cards to be returned to the Hotel by you.

<u>Iohnstown House Hotel and Spa Hotel Rules:</u>

Hotel Office and Out of Hours:

The hotel is open 24 hours a day. In the case of gaining access after midnight, access to the hotel will have to be made through the front main door of the hotel. There is also a bell on this door in case the porter is away working. For any queries, all apartments have phones to connect to the hotel or other apartments. Reminder on Storing Food: As the apartments only have small refrigerators with small freezers guests need to consider bringing only food that can fit in the space. It is recommended that fresh meats and fish will just be bought from Enfield town.

Reminder on Washing Clothes: There is a washer and dryer for each apartment. First load detergent is available so but for subsequent washes guests need to provide own laundry detergent/conditioner.

Reminder in Valuables: Please keep valuables safely kept and locked if possible. There are apartment safe facilities available. Hotel will not be responsible for loss valuables.

5. Dining Room

Dining table is for 4 chairs only.

Things to bring: It is recommended (not required) for each apartment can bring their own extra stools/foldable chairs as they may not be sufficient to seat other guests during fellowship.

Each apartment will take care of its own breakfast and all other meals. This assures that each house can prepare the food that they prefer and kids eat what they like.

During the Street BBQ and Outdoor Activities (14 July) – households may bring picnic blankets, flashlights, portable grill stands and disposable grills. We will be using the paved area near the greens where the apartment rows are located, as it is bigger in surface area. The FC Committee will arrange for having 2 tents and a large /marquee in the event that there is inclement weather.

2. Parking:

There are also ample parking spaces for cars in and around the apartment area. Choose a spot nearest your apartment.

3. Bedrooms:

There are 2 Bedrooms with either en suite or a family bathroom and a WC downstairs with storage area. All rooms have closets (with some hangers) and drawers. There is a TV w/ remote with local channels in each room.

Family Bedrooms – large floor space which can allow 2 adults in the king sized bed and 1 Child (11 years old and below) to sleep between adults or to bring sleeping bag or large duvet. Cot beds will be provided to apartments with young infants.

Linens and Bath Towels: (Provided for max of 6 guests only). Tissue rolls are supplied for two nights only. There are also hotel bar soaps, liquid soap and shampoo in the bathrooms.

<u>Things to bring</u>: Households may bring extra tissues (toilet and kitchen), bed linens, bed sheets, pillows, towels and toiletries (Shampoo, Soap etc).

4. Fully Fitted Kitchen:

In the kitchen there is a standard sized dining table, microwave, small under the counter refrigerator, electric cooker with exhaust, bread toaster, dish washer, and electric kettle.

Things to bring: Bring extra pots and pans if only necessary to cook large meals, rice cooker per house. Bring own drinking water, rice and disposable utensils. Bring liquid dishwashing and hand washing/ anti bacterial soaps for hand washing. Additional food can be bought from near Enfield town (10mins drive away) grocery.

Reminder on Cooking: There is microwave and electric cooker in the apartments so all cooking can be done. There is also dishwasher for washing dishes in bulk.

General Family Camp Rules:

- 1. No Smoking, alcohol or drugs
- 2. Johnstown House Hotel and Spa facilities are ONLY allowed for used by registered Johnstown House Apartment occupants.
- 3. Guests who are coming only during the conferences, teachings, break out sessions or other events without staying for the full duration of the Camp must not be allowed to stay overnight in apartments/hotels without registration*.
 - *Only hotel rooms are available for stay upon registration. For any bookings please approach any FC Committee.
- 4. Guests who are coming only to attend the conferences, teachings, break out sessions or other events will be required to settle a miscellaneous fee*
 - * A miscellaneous fee will be required per guest (adult/youth only) to cover use of the conference rooms and course materials. Please ask any FC Committee for details.
- 5. Boisterous behavior indoors nearly always causes damage, therefore to be avoided. Any damage to Apartment assets to be reported to any FC Committee.
- 6. No playing of loud music in the apartments during the duration of the camp. Singing of Praise and Worship songs during devotions are allowed.
- 7. Sleepovers are not allowed.

- 8. FC Committee in coordination with House Leaders shall be responsible for timekeeping and making sure all household members are informed of the program and reminds all about the next activity. Any sickness or injuries* will be reported immediately to any FC Committee or to any WIN Church Leadership Council member for immediate assistance.
 - * All first aid boxes are at the main hotel. Our Church will also provide first aid kits for use during indoor and outdoor activities.
- 9. House Leaders are to be in charge of keeping house keys/cards. Note that electricity and heating charges are free of charge. Avoid House Key Cards being placed close to Mobile phones as it may disable its use.
- 10. All rubbish (food, toilet) need to be thrown in designated bins inside the apartments at all times. Separate recyclables. The hotel will have arranged a rubbish collection point in the middle car park of the apartments.

Things to bring: For each house bring extra trash bags.

Lights off time to be adhered to at all times.

House Rules for Johnstown Apartments (Self Catering)

1. Check In Time:

The House Leader will need to collect house key cards from the Johnstown House Foyer (Near the Colgan Room) from 3-4pm GMT on 13 July only. In an envelope the FC Committee will provide information as to where the apartments are located, and also a letter from the hotel regarding any information they may need plus also the (2 sets) apartment key cards.

Things to remember: Make sure you know your apartment # ahead of time*. If the House Leader is not available to collect key cards, please advice any FC Committee in advance.

* The complete apartment assignments will be posted in the Church bulletin board and website 2 weeks before the Camp. This will also be emailed along with this document and the program.
