As we waited, the children started to come to the school dressed in their finest outfits. As soon as they were all present, they immediately took their positions and presented us with Christmas songs and Bible verses that they memorized. After their presentation, we, in turn, presented them with gift bags filled with books, pens, toys, and all kinds of presents donated by the members of our church in San Francisco, California. I cannot even begin to describe how excited they were to receive these gifts.







The children were also given Jollibee meal boxes. We were so moved so see the children eating only some of the food and keeping the rest in order to take it home and share with their families. I was warned ahead of time to not be offended if the children did not consume all their food for this very reason. Seeing this kind of behavior was very humbling to us considering how we in America can be so wasteful with our food. Even the teenagers in our team were so amazed and touched to see such a kind gesture from the students.

We are so thankful that Sis. Dina and her husband, Pastor Erick, was there to assist and help us out. Meeting all the children was very life-changing. If only it was possible, we wanted to take them all back with us to the United States. We encourage our church members to really think about Seeds of Hope and to keep this ministry in prayer. We were impressed to see what this ministry had done for the forty-three children and we would like to see more people support this work. By visiting the school, we were able to see for ourselves how Seeds of Hope uses the \$45 quarterly support given for each child. It is impressive to see how such a humble amount can go a long way in giving these children a future that they would not have without our help. All in all, our experience gave us a glimpse of what the ministry does and what it can continue to do for many others.

Our whole experience at Word Int'l. School East - Cainta was nothing short of amazing. We came to be a blessing to these children, but as it turned out, the children were the ones to truly blessed us. We will never forget this experience for as long as we live, and I hope that out of this we will be able to visit our other schools throughout the Philippines in the coming years. We are committed to partnering with Seeds of Hope to do bigger and greater things for our children and the future of our church and country.
